Book Fairs & Reading Events for Families



If your family loves books, reading, and literary fun, there are several exciting events coming up in Southern California that are perfect for kids, parents, and story lovers. Between September 18 and October 1, libraries, museums, and community spaces will be filled with opportunities to spark young imaginations and celebrate the joy of reading.

Nikkei Children's Book Festival — Saturday, September 20, 2025, Japanese American National Museum (Los Angeles). This annual festival celebrates children's literature, family storytelling, and cultural connections. The day includes author readings, Q&A sessions, creative activities, and a special pop-up bookstore. It's an enriching experience for families looking to enjoy books while also exploring Japanese American culture.

Library Happenings Across LA County — Throughout late September, the LA County Library is offering themed storytimes, youth author talks, reading challenges, and special "Staff Picks" programs at various branches. These free local events are perfect for younger readers and caregivers alike.

Orange County Children's Book Festival — Sunday, September 22, 2025, in Costa Mesa. This free, family-friendly festival features dozens of authors and illustrators, storytelling stages, book vendors, and interactive programs. It's one of the largest and most beloved children's book celebrations in the region.

Gardena & Local LA County Library Branches — Branches like Gardena are adding special youth and all-ages events this month. If you're looking for something closer to home, check your local branch calendar for storytimes, book clubs, or drop-in reading sessions.

Fall into Books Fest — Saturday, September 20, 2025, Orange County. While this festival leans toward YA, adult romance, and science fiction/fantasy, it often includes vendor booths and author panels that families can enjoy together. A good option for households with teens or young adult readers.

With options ranging from museum-based celebrations to large-scale festivals and neighborhood library programs, this September is the perfect time to share the love of reading with your family.

Lightness & Tension

Brazilian Design in Los Angeles



September 5 - 19

Christie's Los Angeles opens *Lightness & Tension*, a landmark exhibition curated by Ulysses de Santi. The show brings together two visionary Brazilian designers across generations, offering a rare opportunity to experience their work in direct dialogue.

On one side, visitors encounter the timeless craftsmanship of Joaquim Tenreiro, the mid-century master celebrated for his elegant, sculptural wood furniture that helped define modern design in Brazil. Opposite him stands contemporary artist Lucas Simões, who debuts striking new pieces forged from concrete, metal, and richly upholstered forms. Simões pushes the boundaries of furniture into sculptural territory, creating objects that feel at once architectural and experimental.

By pairing Tenreiro's graceful modernist clarity with Simões' bold material explorations, *Lightness & Tension* creates a layered conversation about tradition, innovation, and the enduring power of design. An immersive exhibition design amplifies this dialogue, inviting visitors to move through the space as though stepping into a living exchange between eras.

For design lovers, collectors, and anyone curious about Brazilian creativity, this exhibition offers a rare chance to see two generations of artistry in conversation — bridging history and the present, refinement and risk, lightness and tension.
